This gift includes the original manuscript of the late Sir Joseph Fayrer's *Recollections of My Life*. It may be noted here that the late Sir Joseph Fayrer served as a Temporary A.S. in the O.M.D., his appointment being dated 6 Dec. 1849. As he was not commissioned by the Crown his name does not appear in this Roll. He had served previously in the R.N. as A.S. from 12 Aug. 1847 to 15 Sept. 1847. He joined the H.E.I.C.S.
